# UNFORGIVENESS, ONE OF SATAN'S DEVICES II COR. 2:5-11

#### Introduction:

- A. We know that Paul believed in the existence of Satan.
  - 1. v11.
  - 2. Paul's estimate of the Devil.
    - a. "prince of the power of the air." Eph. 2:2-
    - b. \*opposes God's work.\* I Thess. 2:18.
    - c. "believers should resist." Rom. 16:20.
    - d. "Satan is powerful." Eph. 2:2.
- B. Paul believed that Satan had devices.
  - 1. "we are not ignorant of his devices."
  - ignorant = agnoeo not to comprehend.
  - 3. devices = noema = that which is thought out, thought, purpose, project.
- C. Paul believed that Satan used devices to gain an advantage at God's people.
  - 1. "lest Satan should get an advantage of us."
  - advantage = pleonekteo to make a prey of, to defraud, to get the better, as an enemy by force of fraud.

## I. THE WORKING OF SATAN, HOW DID IT HAPPEN?

- A. There had been temptation and sin.
  - 1. I Cor. 5:1- "It is reported commonly that there is fornication among you, and such fornication as is not so much as named among the gentiles, that one should have his fathers wife."
  - 2. Sexual sins are often used by satan.
    - a. David and Bathsheba.
- B. This sin had caused grief to the entire body.
  - 1. v5.

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- grief = lupeo to afflict with sorrow.
- overcharge = epibareo to weigh down, press heavily upon, be burdensome upon.
- C. The church had punished the fornicator. v6
  - 1. I Cor. 5:3-5, Paul's orders.
  - 2. punishment = enitimia spoken of the estimate fixed by a judge on the infringement of civil rights and citizenship, penalty, judicial infliction.
  - They had taken away his church rights in a public meeting.
- D. It was time to forgive and restore.
  - v7, swallow up = Katapino to drink down.
- E. It would confirm their love. v8
  - confirm Kurosiai = to ratify with authority by some public or formal act.
- F. It would be proof of their obedience to God's word. v9
  "to pass a test."
  - 1. Too eager to punish, not eager to restore.
- G. Paul would do his Christian duty. v10
  - Perhaps Paul had been maligned by this occurrence more than anyone.
  - 2. II Sam. 1:11-12.
- H. To refuse to forgive would give satan an added advantage 1. v11.
- II. THE CIRCUMSTANCES THAT COULD DEVELOP FROM SATAN'S DEVICES.

  II COR. 12:20.
  - A. If they had not followed Paul's instruction in this matter, both in exclusion and restoration, the church would have suffered immeasurably.

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- 1. This is one of the great problems in our work.
- 2. It has ever been a problem.
- B. What would these things have been?
  - debates = eris = quarrels, wordy-wranglings.
  - envyings = zeloo heartburning jealousy.
  - wraths = thumos = the working and fermenting of the mind, the demonstration of strong passion which may issue in revenge.
  - 4. strifes = eritheia = labour for wages; hence, canvassing, intriguing; party spirit, faction.
  - 5. backbitings = Katalalia a speaking against, open evil speaking as opposed to whisperings.
  - 6. whisperings = psithuristes to whisper what one does not speak out, a secret slandering.
  - 7. swellings = phusiosis a puffing up.
  - tumults = akatasasia instability; hence, disorder, sedition.
  - 9. v21, bewail = go into mourning.
