THE CHURCH IN JERUSALEM

ACTS 5:12-16

Introduction:

- A. The Jerusalem church shared
 - 1) Vs. 34: 4:34 "Neither was there any of......"
 - 2) Barnabas was an example
- B. Annias and Sapphira entered into a conspiracy
 - 1) 5:1-2 ("they formed a "symphony")
 - 2) God dealt with them severely
- C. The churches reaction
 - 1) "Great fear" Vs. 11
 - 2) They didn't quit serving! What did they do?
- I. The Apostles Kept Working Vs. 12a
 - A. "And by the hands of the apostles were many signs and wonders wrought among the people"
 - 1) The intensity of it Vs. 15, portable cots
 - 2) The extent of it Vs. 16,

God always does what is best and works best!

- B. What about this work now?
 - 1) There are no apostles in this age
 - 2) The gift of healing has ceased Vs. 16b "and they were healed everyone." I Cor. 13:8-13
- II. The Church Kept Meeting Vs. 12b
 - A. "and they were all with one accord in Solomon's porch."
 - 1) "accord" = omothumadon = alike + mind
 - 2) Solomon's colonade

- B. We must never forsake assembling!
 - 1) The body weakens The only way to kill a church! NON-ATTENDANCE
 - 2) The body dies
 - 3) Body is the sum total of its members
- III. The World Rejected the Church Vs. 13
 - A. "And of the rest durst no man join himself to them"
 - 1) "rest" = oi loipoi = "the others"
 - 2) "durst" = "dare" = tolmao = "to do or to bear anything terrible or difficult"
 - 3) "Join" = kallao = colage = "to glue together", "to adhere to, or cleave to"
 - B. "but the people magnified them"
 - "magnified" = megaluno = "to make great", "enlarge", "to praise",
 "held in high esteem"
- IV. God Blessed the Church Vs. 14
 - A. "And believers were the more added to the Lord, Vs. 14
 - 1) "believers" = pisteuo = "to trust", "be persuaded"
 - 2) "added" = prostithemi = "to put one thing to another"
 - B. "Multitudes both of men and women"
 - 1) "multitudes" = plethos = "a great number"
 - 2) More than Sunday School campaigns!
- V. What Are We To Learn?
 - 1) That the world should respect the church
 - 2) Unity of mind is important
