Paul's Prayer For The Colossians

Colossians 1:9-12

Intro:

- A. Paul was a man of love.
 - 1. He loved God.
 - 2. He loved Jesus.
 - 3. He loved the saints and he loved the church.
 - 4. He loved the <u>truth</u>, he loved <u>fellow servants</u> of the Lord.
- B. Paul prayed for those people that he loved.
 - 1. Jesus set the example.
 - 2. Sometimes pray amiss.
 - 3. A mother prays that her son will not get caught.
 - 4. A father prays that his <u>hit and run</u> son will not be punished.
 - 5. Sometimes we should pray that the consequences of one's sin might find them out and that this might correct them.
- C. Vs. 9a The basis of Paul's prayer.
 - 1. "For this very reason..."
 - 2. "from the first time we heard"
 - 3. "and do not cease to pray for you"

I. Paul Prayed For Them To Be Filled.

- A. "...and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will..."
 - 1. "Desire" = $\alpha \iota T \in \omega$ = "to ask for something".
 - 2. "Filled" = $\pi\lambda\eta\rho\omega$ = "to fill".
 - 3. "Knowledge" = $\epsilon \pi i \gamma \nu \omega \sigma i S =$ "thoroughly acquainted".
 - 4. "Will" = $\theta \in \lambda \eta \mu \alpha$ = "active volition".
 - 5. "Clear knowledge of what His will is" Gspd
- B. "...in all wisdom and spiritual understanding;"
 - 1. "Wisdom" = $\sigma \phi \alpha$ = "mental excellency in it's highest". The capacity to apply God's truth to the day to day challenges of life.
 - 2. "Spiritual" = $\eta \nu \in \nu \mu \alpha \tau \iota \kappa \circ S$ = "influenced by the Holy Spirit" not from the world.
 - 3. "Understanding" = συνεσις = "intelligence", "insight", "the intelligent penetrating

II. He Prayed For Them To Live Correctly.

- A. Vs. 10 "That ye might walk worthy of the Lord, unto all pleasing..."
 - 1. "Walk" = $\pi \in \rho \in \pi \cap \tau \in \omega$ = "to walk about", "to conduct one's life", "the way one lives".
 - 2. "Worthy" = $\alpha \xi \log =$ "of like worth". They were to match the worthy walk of Jesus with the way they walked.
 - 3. "Pleasing" = $\alpha \rho \in \sigma \in \alpha = \text{"desire of pleasing",}$ "seeking to please one's benefactor".
- B. "being fruitful in every good work,"
 - 1. "Fruitful" = καρποφορ $\epsilon \omega$ = "to bear fruit".
 - 2. "in active goodness of every kind".
- C. "and increasing in the knowledge of God."
 - 1. "Increasing" = $\alpha \nu \xi \alpha \nu \omega$ = "to grow", "to grow up".
 - 2. "Knowledge" = $\epsilon \pi i \gamma \nu \omega \sigma i S$ = "clear and exact knowledge".
 - 3. "and growing continually by learning more about God."

III. He Prayed For Them To Be Strengthened.

- A. Vs. 11 "Strengthened with all might, according to his glorious power..."
 - 1. "Strengthened" = $\delta \nu \mu \omega \omega$ = "to make powerful", "to strengthen".
 - 2. "<u>Might</u>" = Kρατος = "strength" The inherent power which displays itself in the control of others.
 - 3. "Since His power is so glorious, may you be strengthened with strength of every kind." Wey
- B. "...unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness."
 - 1. "Patience" = ὑπομονη = "a remaining under".
 - 2. "Longsuffering" = μ ακροθυ μ ε ω = "to be long-minded", "slow to anger, to passion".
 - 3. "Joyfulness" = $\chi \alpha \rho \alpha$ = "delight, gladness".
 - 4. "For the cheerful exercise of unlimited patience and perseverance" Ber

IV. Paul Prayed For Them To Be Thankful.

- A. Vs. 12 "Giving thanks unto the Father,"
 - 1. "Thanks" = $\epsilon \nu \chi \alpha \rho \iota \sigma \tau \epsilon \omega$ = "to show one's self to be grateful".
 - 2. Paul was grateful and the Colossians should express their gratitude to God.
- B. "which made us meet..."
 - 1. "Meet" = $i\kappa\alpha\nu\omega\omega$ = "to make sufficient", "to render competent", "to make adequate".
 - 2. "who made you sufficient".
- C. "...to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light;"
 - 1. "Partakers" = " $\epsilon \iota \varsigma$ " = "unto", "for the", + $\mu \epsilon \rho \iota \varsigma$ = "assigned part", "division", "portion".
 - 2. "Inheritance" = $\kappa\lambda\eta\rho\sigma$ = "that which is assigned by lot", "a possession".
 - 3. "God has prepared us to receive our portion of the land of light."
- D. God has done this.
 - 1. It is by His grace.
 - 2. It is, "Reserved in heaven for you."
