THE SAVING GRACE OF GOD [By grace ye are saved.] Eph. 2:4-10, (v5)

Introduction:

- A. Mankind is incapable of self-deliverance.
 - 1. He is "dead in tresspasses and sins."
 - 2. He is "by nature the children of wrath."
- B. Man is a sinner by choice.
 - 1. "fulfilling the desires of the flesh and mind."
 - 2. The mind consents to the flesh.
- C. God must intervene.
 - 1. He must become, author and finisher.
 - 2. The Spirit witnesses to God's truth.
- I. GOD'S GRACE IS LOVE AND MERCY. V4
 - A. "But God."
 - "who is rich in mercy."
 - a. rich = plousios = abounding in riches.
 - b. mercy = eleos = active compassion for miserable.
 - "for his great love wherewith he loves us."
 - B. "For God." John 3:16.
 - 1. "So loved the world."
 - "He gave His only begotten son."
- II. GOD'S GRACE IS UNDESERVED. V5
 - A. We were dead.
 - dead = nekros = a judicial sentence.
 - 2. sins = paraptoma = sin because of ignorance.
 - B. He "quickened" us = suksoopeieo -= to make alive in conjunction with another, by grace ye are saved.

III. GOD'S GRACE LIFTS UPWARD. V6

- A. "and hath raised us up together."
 - raise = sunegeiro = sun together with + egeiro to cause to rise up.
- B. "and made us to sit together in heavenly places in Christ."
 - 1. sit = sugkathikso = together or in conjuction with.
 - 2. sitting together as the church.

IV. GOD'S GRACE GLORIFIES GOD. V7

- A. "That in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in his Kindness toward us through Christ Jesus."
 - 1. ages = aion = time or a space of time.
 - 2. shew = ekdeiknumi = to display, to prove.
 - riches = ploutos = wealth.
 - 4. grace = charis = a kind, affectionate, pleasing nature and dispositions.
 - 5. Kindness = chrestotes = active beneficence in spite of ingratitude.

V. GOD'S GRACE IS RECEIVED THROUGH FAITH. V8

- A. "for by grace are ye saved through faith."
 - 1. grace = charis.
 - saved = sozo = preserve safe from danger, loss or destruction.
 - faith = pistis = the conviction which is based on hearing, not sight, a firmly relying confidence.
- B. "and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God"
 - 1. gift = doron = a gift, a present, an honorary gift.
 - not of yourselves = ouk not + humon = of you.
 - 3. It came from an outside source.

VI. GOD'S GRACE EXCLUDES BOASTING. V9

- A. "not of works."
 - Not = ouk = not, no.
 - works = ergon = that which is brought into being by labor, work as a single act.
- B. *lest any man should boast."
 - lest = hina to the end that,; me not.
 - boast = Kauchaomai = to speak loud, to be loud tongued, to vaunt oneself.

VII. GOD'S GRACE CREATES WORKMEN. V10

- A. "for we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works."
 - workmanship = poiema = a thing made, a thing produced, as with effort, object, and design.
 - created = Ktizo = to bring under tillage and settlement, to people a country, to found, set up, bring into being.
 - good = hagathos = worthy of admiration.
 - works = ergon = deed, that which is brought into being or accomplished by labor.
- B. "which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them."
 - ordained = proetimazo = to prepare before hand.
 - walk = peripateo = to be walking, to tread about.

VIII. GOD'S GRACE IS AVAILABLE. V11,12,13

- A. He is available to sinners.
 - "Gentiles in the flesh."
 - Already strangers, "having no hope."
- B. "are made night by the blood of Christ."
