## Galatians 3:4-9

## Intro:

- A. Paul has asked his readers 5 questions.
  - 1. Who bewitched you? Vs. 1
  - 2. How did they receive the Spirit? Vs. 2
  - 3. How will they be completed? Vs. 3
- B. "Have ye suffered so many things in vain? If it be yet in vain."
  - 1. "Suffered" =  $\pi \alpha \sigma \kappa \omega$  = "to experience either good or evil", "to receive from evil".
  - 2. "Vain" =  $\epsilon$ ικη = "to no purpose".
  - 3. "Have all of your experiences achieved no end at all? If it really was to no purpose."
- C. By what agency had God worked among them?
  - 1. **Vs. 5** "Ministereth" =  $\epsilon \pi i \chi o \rho \eta \gamma \epsilon \omega$  = "to furnish upon, that is besides, in addition, supply further".
  - 2. "Worketh" =  $\epsilon \rho \gamma o \nu$  = "accomplish by labor".
  - 3. "Miracles" =  $\delta \nu \alpha \mu \iota \varsigma$  = "inherent power", "capability".
  - 4. "He who supplies you abundantly with his Spirit and endows you with such powers does he do this as the result of obedience to Law? Or is it the result of hearing and believing? TCNT
- I. Justification Comes to the Jew by Faith. Vs. 6-7
  - A. "Even as Abraham believed God..."
    - 1. "Think of Abraham..."
    - 2. "Believed" =  $\pi$ ιστενω = "to trust"
    - 3. "Just like Abraham trusted God..."
  - B. "...and it was accounted to him for righteousness."
    - 1. "Accounted" =  $\lambda o \gamma i \zeta o \mu \alpha i = "to count, to reckon".$
    - 2. "Righteousness" =  $\delta$ ικαιοσυνη = "the sum total of all that God requires".
  - C. **Vs.** 7
- II. Justification come to the Gentiles by Faith.
  - A. Vs. 8 "And the scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the heathen through faith,..."
    - 1. "Scripture" =  $\gamma \rho \alpha \phi \eta$  = "the writing".

- "Foreseeing" =  $\pi \rho oo \rho a\omega$  = "to see before hand". 2.
- "Heathen" =  $\epsilon\theta\nu$ os = "nation". 3.
- "...preached the gospel unto Abraham, saying, In thee B. shall all nations be blessed."
  - προευαγγελιζομαι = "to proclaim a joyous correct message beforehand".
  - Genesis 12:3 (1-3) 2.
- III. Jew and Gentile Share in the Justification.
  - Vs. 9 "So then they which be of faith..."
    1. "Faith" = See I,A,2 Α.

    - "So we see that all who trust God..."
  - "...are blessed with faithful Abraham..." В.
    - "Blessed" =  $\epsilon \nu \lambda \circ \gamma \epsilon \omega$  = "to speak well of" a eulogy, to praise, her to be praised by God as Abraham was.
    - We are partakers with Abraham because we have received the one promised to him, that is Christ 2. Jesus.
