Standfast In Freedom

Galatians 5:1-6

Intro:

- A. Paul has presented and <u>allegory</u> to the churches.
 - They are not of <u>Haggar</u>, Mt. Sinai, or the "now" Jerusalem of Ishmael.
 - They are of <u>Isaac</u>, <u>Sarah</u>, "<u>Above</u>" <u>Jerusalem</u> and are children of promise, of the freewoman and not of 2. the bondwoman.
 - They are free from all past religious bondage. 3.
 - Those who were "many" persecuted those who had few.
- What will they do with this freedom?

 1. Will they live in its glory? B.

 - Will they return bondage?

Ι. Paul's Plea To Standfast In Freedom.

- Vs. "Standfast therefore in the <u>liberty</u> wherewith Christ Α. hath made us <u>free</u>..."
 - "Standfast" = $\sigma \tau \eta \kappa \omega$ = "to stand firm". The pres. tense indicates a habitual action.
 - "Liberty" = $\epsilon \lambda \epsilon \nu \theta \epsilon \rho \iota \alpha$ = "freedom to go where one 2. will".
 - "Free" = $\epsilon \lambda \epsilon \nu \theta \epsilon \rho \omega =$ "to set at liberty".
- "...and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage." В.
 - "Entangled" = $\epsilon \nu \epsilon \chi \omega$ = Pass. "to be held in or by 1. anything"
 - "Yoke" = $\zeta u \lambda o s = yoke$ 2.
 - "Bondage" = δουλεια = slavery 3.
 - "Cease being held out by the yoke of slavery (to Judaism or Paganism)"

II. Christ, Circumcision, And The Law.

- Vs. 2 "Behold, I Paul say unto you,..." Α.
 - Listen! I Paul, say this to you..." Phi
 - "You can say, Paul said this". "You can quote me". 2.
- B. "if ye be circumcised, Christ shall profit me nothing."
 - "Profit" = $\omega \phi \epsilon \lambda \epsilon \omega$ = "to further", "to help"
 - If these people were depending upon the law of Moses (for righteousness) Christ could not help them.
- C. "For I testify again to every man that is circumcised, that he is debtor to do the whole law."

- 1. "Testify" = $\mu\alpha\rho\tau\nu\rho\rho\mu\alpha\iota$ = "to attest to truth".
- "Debtor" = $0\phi\epsilon\iota\lambda\epsilon\tau\eta\varsigma$ = "one who is morally obligated 2. to fulfill a debt".
- "I testify again to every man who submits to 3. circumcision, that he thereby lays himself under obligation to fulfill the whole law" - Con

III. Standing Beyond The Reach Of Grace.

- Α. Vs. 4 Christ is become of no effect unto you,"
 - "Effect" = καταργεω = "to leave unemployed", or 1. idle, "make useless", "void", "abolish".
 - "You have voided and made useless the work of 2. Christ."
- В. "...<u>Whosoever</u> of you are <u>justified</u> by law..."
 - "Justified" = $\delta \iota \kappa \alpha \iota \omega = to$ set forth as righteous.
 - 2.
 - "If you <u>trust</u> in the law for your righteousness..." Christ was idle as their Saviour if they were 3. trusting in law-keeping to make them righteous in God's sight.
- C. "...ye are fallen from grace."
 - "Fallen" = $\epsilon \kappa \pi \iota \pi \tau \omega$ = "to fall out of".
 - "...you put yourself outside the range of his 2. grace". - Phi
 - 3. "...you have deserted grace."
 - Those who seek to be righteous by law-keeping are 4.
 - standing on ground that grace cannot reach.

 Romans 11:6 "And if by grace, then it is no more 5. of works: otherwise grace is no more grace. But if it be of works, then it is no more grace: otherwise work is no more work."

IV. How They Were Saved.

- Α. Vs. 5 "For we through the Spirit wait for the hope of righteousness by faith."
 - "All our hope of justification lies in the Spirit: It (our hope) rests on our faith." Knox
 - "The Spirit empowers us to wait in hope to see the 2. results of our being justified by faith."
- Vs. 6 "For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth В. anything, nor uncircumcision; but faith which worketh by love."
 - "Availeth" = $\epsilon \sigma \chi \nu \omega$ = "to be prevailing", "to be 1. mighty", "to have strength".
 - 2. "Worketh" = $\epsilon \nu \epsilon \rho \gamma \epsilon \omega$ = "to energize".
 - "Once we are in Christ, circumcision means nothing, 3. and the want of it means nothing; the faith that

finds its expression in love is all that matters" - Knox
