## INTRODUCTION:

- A. God's people are to live by faith
  - 1) We must be just 10:38
  - 2) Faith must be the foundation
- B. By having faith the men of old had a good testimony before God.
  - 1) Faith is believing God 11:2
  - 2) Faith is a "moving" force
- I. The History Of Abel's Offering To God
  - A. Things Cain and Abel had in common Genesis 4:1-15 (4)
    - 1) They had the same parents
    - 2) They had the same home life
    - 3) They had the same religious training
    - 4) They were both mature heads of families
    - 5) They were both responsible men
    - 6) They had the same opportunities
    - 7) They both made an offering
  - B. Abel's offering pleased God
    - 1) He brought the right offering
    - 2) These people knew what God required
    - 3) It was a "shed blood" offering
    - 4) It was brought in faith
  - C. Cain's offering was not accepted
    - 1) It was without blood shed
    - 2) Hebrews 9:22
    - 3) It was without faith

- II. Abel's Offering To God, An Analysis
  - A. "By faith Abel offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain..."
    - 1) "offered" =  $\pi \rho \circ \sigma \phi \in \rho \omega$  = "to bear or bring towards any place or person", "to offer", "to present"
    - 2) "excellent" =  $\pi\lambda\epsilon\iota\omega\nu$  = "more", "greater" thus pleasing
    - 3) "sacrifice" = θυσια = "the act of killing and offering in sacrifice"
    - 4) "Faith made Abel's sacrifice greater in the sight of God than Cain's..." GSPD
  - B. "...by which he obtained witness that he was righteous..."
    - 1) "obtained" =  $\mu\alpha\rho\tau\nu\rho\epsilon\omega$  = "to have good witness", "to obtain attestation"
    - 2) "witness" = (see above)
    - 3) "righteous" = δικαιος = "right", "just" Fulfilling all claims which are right and becoming; just as it should be; a right state, of which God is the standard.
    - 4) "...God approved of him as being righteous..."
  - C. "God testifying of his gifts:..."
    - 1) "testifying" =  $\mu\alpha\rho\tau\nu\rho\epsilon\omega$  = "to witness in favour"
    - 2) "gifts" =  $\delta\omega\rho\sigma\nu$  = "a present", "a motive offering"
    - 3) "for God acknowledged his gifts" BER
    - 4) Hatthew 23:35 "the blood of rightcous Abel..."
  - D. "...and by it he being dead yet speaketh."
    - 1) "dead" = αποθνησκω = "to become quite dead"
    - 2) "speaketh" = λαλεω = "to speak" Μεκαλειται = "is spoken of" The testimony of God was used continually of Abel.
    - 3) "and because of his faith he is still spoken of"
