BY FAITH ABRAHAM...

Hebrews 11:8-10

INTRODUCTION:

- A. Faith is that which the just should live by
 - 1) "Now the just shall live by faith ... "
 - 2) This is after we are declared "just"
 - 3) Without it we cannot be well-pleasing to God vs 6
- B. Faith is two things to the just
 - 1) It is the foundation of our decisions
 - 2) It is the evidence that we are all that God wants us to be.
- C. By it the elders received a good report
 - 1) "By faith Abel..."
 - 2) "By faith Enoch..."
 - 3) "By faith Noah..."
- I. By Faith Abraham...Obeyed vs 8
 - A. "By faith Abraham, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, obeyed..."
 - 1) "called" = $\kappa \alpha \lambda \epsilon \omega$ = "to call anyone", "summons"
 - 2) "go out" = εξερχομαι = "to go forth"
 - 3) "obeyed" = υπακουω = "to listen to", "to obey"
 - B. "...and he went out, not knowing, whither he went."
 - 1) "not knowing" = οπισταμαι = "to understand", "to know"
 - 2) "By faith Abraham on being called, obeyed the command to to forth into a place, that would be his, and he set out not knowing where he was going."

- C. The call of Abraham Genesis 12:1-9
 - 1) "...the Lord said unto Abram..."
 - 2) "...unto a land that I will show thee"
- D. The obedience of Abraham
 - 1) "So Abram departed..."
 - 2) "...as the Lord had spoken unto him..."
- II. By Faith Abraham...sojourned vs 9
 - A. "By faith he sojourned in the land of promise..." vs 9
 - 1) "sojourned" = $\pi\alpha\rho$ oiks ω = "to dwell along side of", "to be a foreigner residing in a foreign country"
 - 2) "land" = $\gamma \eta$ = "earth", "land"
 - B. "...as in a strange country..."
 - 1) "strange" = αλλοτριος = "alien", "not one's own"
 - 2) "as in a land not his own" ASV
 - C. "...dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise:"
 - 1) "dwelling" = κατοικεω = "to settle down in a fixed
 dwelling", "to dwell fixedly in a place"
 - 2) "tabernacle" = $\sigma \kappa \eta \nu \eta$ = "any covered sheltered place", "a tent"
 - 3) αυτος = "very", "self-same", "the very same"
 - 4) "He lived in tents like a mere visitor" TAY
- III. By Faith Abraham...looked vs 10
 - A. "For he looked for a city which hath foundations..."
 - 1) "looked" = $\varepsilon \kappa \delta \varepsilon \chi \omega \omega \omega =$ "to wait expectantly", "to be prepared to deal with a situation"
 - 2) "city" = $\pi \circ \lambda i \zeta$ = "a town enclosed with a wall"

- B. "...whose builder and maker is God."
 - 1) "builder" = τεχνιτης = "an artificer; one who does or handles a thing by the rules of art"
 - 2) "maker" = $\delta\eta\mu\iota\sigma\nu\rho\gamma\sigma\varsigma$ = "a handicraftsman" Used by the Greeks as the name for the maker of the world.
 - 3) "foundation" = θεμελιας = "placed or laid as a foundation" He looked for a laid-out city.
- IV. The City They Looked For Revelation 21:1-4
 - A. It is in a better world
 - 1) "And I saw a new heaven and a new earth"
 - 2) "for the first heaven and the first earth are passed away;"
 - B. It is in a better country
 - 1) Hebrews 11:16
 - 2) "but now they desire a better country, that is an heavenly;"
 - C. It is a better city
 - 1) Hebrews 12:22
 - 2) "... Hount Sion, the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem..."
 - 3) It is a continuing city Hebrews 13:14
 - 4) Revelation 21:2 "...the holy city, New Jerusalem..."
 - 5) Jesus is building it John 14:1-4
