BY FAITH...

Hebrews 11:20-23

INTRODUCTION:

- A. The elders were men of faith
 - 1) By it they obtained a good report
 - 2) It was the basis of their testimony
- B. Faith must be the foundation of our lives
 - 1) Without it we cannot please Him
 - 2) With it we can do what He teaches
- I. By Faith Isaac... vs 20
 - A. "By faith Isaac blessed Jacob and Esau concerning things to come"
 - 1) "blessed" = ευλογεω = "to speak well of", "to invoke
 God's blessing"
 - 2) περι μελλοντα = "concerning future coming things"
 - 3) It was faith that enabled Isaac to speak to his sons in regard to their future.
 - B. The history Genesis 27:1
 - 1) Isaac was old and nearing death
 - 2) He sent for Esau to bestow the blessing (promises) of God
 - 3) Rebekah heard and plotted with Jacob to deceive Isaac
 - 4) The plot worked and Jacob received the blessing 27:28-29
 - 5) Isaac blessed Esau 27:38-39
- II. By Faith Jacob... vs 21
 - A. "By faith Jacob, when he was a dying, blessed both the sons of Joseph;..."
 - 1) "dying" = $\alpha\pi o\theta v\eta\sigma\kappa\omega v$ = "He was in the process of dying"
 - 2) "both" = εκαστος = "each one"

- B. "...and worshipped, leaning upon the top of his staff."
 - 1) "worshipped" = προσκυνεω = "to worship"
 - 2) "staff" = $\rho \alpha \beta \delta o \varsigma$ = "stick", "staff"
 - 3) "And gave God worship, supported by his staff" BAS
- C. The history Genesis 48:1
 - 1) Joseph came to his sick father
 - 2) He brought his two sons Manaseh and Epharaim
 - 3) The two sons of Joseph each became the heads of tribes
- III. By Faith Joseph... vs 22
 - A. "By faith Joseph, when he died, made mention of the departing of the children of Israel:..."
 - 1) "died" = τελευταω = "to come to the end"
 - 2) "made mention" = μνημονευω = "call to mind", "bear in mind", "to speak of"
 - 3) "departing" = $\varepsilon\xi \circ \delta \circ \varsigma = "a way out", "exit"$
 - 4) "Confidently spoke of God bringing the people of Israel out of Egypt" TAY
 - 5) He remembered that they would depart. God had told him they would exodus.
 - B. "...and gave commandment concerning his bones."
 - 1) "commandment" = εντελλομαι = "to charge with", "to
 enjoin upon"
 - 2) "And gave instructions concerning the burying site for his bones"
 - C. The history Genesis 50:24-26
 - 1) Joseph was dwelling in Egypt
 - 2) He did not forget God's covenant
 - 3) By faith he made request of his sons
 - 4) Exodus 13:19 "And Moses took the bones of Joseph with him: for he had straitly sworn the children of Israel, saying, God will surely visit you; and ye shall carry up my bones away hence with you."

- IV. By Faith (the parents of) Moses vs 23
 - A. "By faith Moses, when he was born, was hid three months of his parents, because they saw he was a proper child;..."
 - 1) "hid" = κρυπτω = "conceal", "keep secret"
 - 2) "parents" = $\pi \alpha \tau \eta \rho$ = "a father", here plural, therefore both father and mother.
 - 3) "proper" = αστειος = "elegant", "fair", "to be
 exceedingly fair"
 - B. "...and they were not afraid of the King's commandment."
 - 1) "afraid" = φοβεομαι = "to be terrified"
 - 2) "And the King's edict had no terror for them"
 - C. The history Exodus 2:1-10
 - 1) "goodly" = "good"
 - 2) The decision to cast him on to the providence of God rather than have him "discovered" was an act of faith.
