# THE DEAD AND THE COMING OF JESUS I THESS. 4:13-14

#### Introduction:

- A. The Thessalonians were grieving because they did not know the relationship of their dead to the appearing of Jesus.
  - 1. Timothy had probably brought word.
  - Early in church history, some of their members had died since missionaries had left.
- B. Paul reveals to them the truth.
  - 1. "the word of the Lord." v15
  - 2. They are to be comforted. v18
- I. IGNORANCE IS NOT GOD'S WILL.
  - A. "I would not have you to be ignorant."
    - ignorant = agnostic = no knowledge.
    - 2. These people had a reason, we don't.
  - b. There is freedom in knowing.
    - 1. Ignorance is a slavemaster.
    - 2. Revelation and faith to accept the truth.
- II. "CONCERNING THEM WHICH ARE ASLEEP."
  - asleep = those sleeping, lying asleep, or those falling asleep from time to time.
  - B. Jesus used this figurative speech.
    - 1. Mark 5:39 "And when He was come in, He saith unto them, Why make ye this ado, and weep? the damsel is not dead, but sleepeth."
    - 2. It reflects such a state as temporary.
    - 3. Early Christians called their burial places [Kamateria] cemetry, dormitrory.

- C. The Bible plainly reveals the state of dead.
  - 1. Souls are in "paradise". Jesus and the thief.
  - 2. II Cor. 5:8 "present with the Lord."
  - 3. It is sown to be raised.
    - a. I Cor. 15:35-38.
  - 4. Phil. 1:23 "For I am in a strait betwix two, having a desire to depart, and to be with Christ; which is far better..."

## III. "THAT YE SORROW NOT."

- A. sorrow = grieve.
  - There is a sorrow, but we should not grieve as though all were lost and over.
  - 2. "Not as the pagans." Four testimonies.
    - a. Cutting, flailing, mourning.
    - b. Aeschylus = "of a man once dead, there is no resurrection."
    - c. Theoriitus = "hopes are among the living, the dead are without hope."
    - d. Catullus = "Suns may set and rise again but we, when once our brief light goes down must sleep an endless night."
    - e. Lucretius = "No one wakes and rises who has been overtaken by the chilling end of life."

#### IV. ASSURANCE CONCERNING THE DEAD. V14

- A. "if" does not imply doubt, it recognizes an assumed truth.
  - 1. "We do believe that Jesus died and rose again."
  - 2. "In the same manner the dead in Christ will be raised and Jesus will bring them back with Him."

### V. "ASLEEP IN JESUS."

- A. Resting in Jesus.
- B. Adequately describes our faith in Him as Saviour.
