HOW TO SAVE ONE'S MINISTRY

I Timothy 4:12-16

Intro:

- A. Timothy was a man of the book.
 - He had known the Scriptures from a youth.
 - 2. He had nourished himself in the word and in the true doctrines. Vs 6b
- B. As an example to the Elders of the church at Ephesus, he was to seek to behave himself.
 - 1. There were certain things he should do.
 - 2. There were things he should not do.
 - 3. In following Paul's instruction he would be able to "save" himself. Vs 16b

I. Overcoming The Problem Of Youth. Vs 12

- A. "Let no man despise thy youth:..."
 - 1. "Despise" = Καταφρονεω = "to think down".
 - 2. "Youth" = $\nu \in OT\eta S$ = "newness", "recent", "youth".
 - 3. "Let no one look down on your youthfulness". NEB
- B. "...but be thou an example of the believers..."
 - 1. "Example" = TUTOS = "type".
 - 2. "Make yourself a model to the others...".
- C. "...in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity."
 - 1. "Word" = $\lambda 0 \gamma 0 \varsigma$ = "speech".
 - 2. "Conversation" = αναστροφη = "mode of life".
 - 3. "Charity" = $\alpha \gamma \alpha \pi \eta$ = "love like Gods".
 - 4. "Faith" = $\pi \iota \sigma \tau \iota \varsigma$ = "firm persuasion".
 - 5. "Purity" = $\alpha \gamma \nu \in l\alpha$ = "chaste", "innocence, and integrity, all stemming from a pure heart".

II. Overcoming The Problem Of Laxness.

- A. Vs 13 "Till I come, give attendance to reading,..."
 - 1. "Until I arrive..."
 - 2. "Attendance" = $\pi\rho\sigma\sigma\in\chi\omega$ = "to hold to", "to turn one's mind", "to attach one's self".
 - 3. "Reading" = $\alpha \nu \alpha \gamma \nu \omega \sigma \iota \varsigma$ = "knowing by reading".
- B. "...to exhortation, "to doctrine."
 - 1. "Exhortation" = $\pi\alpha\rho\alpha\kappa\lambda\eta\tau\sigma\sigma$ = "a calling near", "to call one's side to give encouragement".
 - 2. "Doctrine" = $\delta \iota \delta \alpha \sigma \kappa \alpha \lambda \iota \alpha$ = "the substance or the result of teaching".

III. Overcoming The Problem Of Neglect.

- A. Vs 14 "Neglect not the gift that is in thee..."
 - 1. "Neglect" = $\alpha\mu\epsilon\lambda\epsilon\omega$ = "not to care for".
 - 2. "Gift" = $\chi \alpha \rho \iota \sigma \mu \alpha$ = "a special endowment of the Spirit".
- B. "...which was given thee by prophecy, by the laying on of the hands of the presbytery."
 - 1. "Conferred on you by prophetic indication". WEY
 - "When the hands of the elders were placed on you".
 WEY
 - 3. When Timothy was ordained he was given a spiritual gift. We do not know which one. We do know he could become careless about it and it's purpose.

IV. Overcoming Lack Of Growth.

- A. Vs 15 "Meditate upon these things;..."
 - 1. "Meditate" = $\mu \in \lambda \in T\alpha \omega$ = "to take care for anything, so as to be able to do it", "to cultivate"
 - 2. "Keep on cultivating these things"
- B. "...give thyself wholly to them;..."
 - 1. $\in \iota \mu \iota = "be in them"$.
 - 2. "Be totally absorbed in these things".

- C. "...that thy profiting may appear to all."
 - 1. "Profiting" = $\pi \rho O K O \pi \eta$ = "advance", "progress".
 - 2. "Appear" = $\phi \alpha \nu \epsilon \rho o \varsigma$ = "obvious", "clear".
- V. Overcoming The Desire To Quit. Vs 16
 - A. "Take heed unto thyself, and unto the doctrine; continue in them..."
 - 1. "Pay close attention to yourself..." NASB
 - 2. "Doctrine" = δ ιδασκαλια = "what has been taught".
 - 3. "Continuous" = $\xi \pi \iota \mu \in V \omega$ = "to remain upon".
 - 4. "Stick to your work" MOF
 - B. "...for in doing this thou shalt both save thyself, and them that hear thee."
 - 1. "For in so doing..."
 - 2. "Save" = $\sigma\omega\zeta\omega$ = "to rescue".
 - 3. "Hear" = $\alpha \kappa \omega \omega$ = "to learn by hearing".
 - 4. "You will deliver yourself and all those who hear your message will be saved."
