#### THE CHURCH AND THE TRUTH

## I Timothy 3:14-16

#### Intro:

- A. Paul has instructed Timothy in regard to the offices of the church.
  - 1. The office of a bishop. vs 1-7
  - 2. The office of a deacon. vs 8-13
  - 3. He has also taught Timothy many other truths that have to do with the church.
  - 4. Primarily, he addresses false teachers.
- B. Paul hopes to come to Ephesus shortly.
  - 1. Vs 14 "These things write unto thee, hoping to come unto thee shortly:"
  - 2. "Shortly" =  $T\alpha\chi\iota o\nu$  = "fast", "quickly".
- C. If Paul doesn't come to Ephesus very soon, Timothy should use the truths Paul has written and will write as a guide for teaching the Ephesians.
  - 1 "But if I am delayed..."
  - 2. "What your conduct ought to be..." TENT

### I. The Church, The Pillar And Ground Of Truth.

- A. Vs 15 "But if I tarry long, that thou mayest know how thou oughtest to behave thyself in the house of God,..."
  - 1. "Tarry long" =  $\beta \rho \alpha \delta \nu \omega$  = "to be slow", "to hesitate", "to delay".
  - 2. "Know" =  $01\delta\alpha$  = "the word was used to describe "know-how", that is the knowledge or skill to accomplish a thing".
  - 3. "Behave" =  $\alpha\nu\alpha\sigma\tau\rho\epsilon\phi\omega$  = "to move about", "to turn around", "to conduct one's self".
  - 4. "House of God" = OLKOS = "a house", "a dwelling".
    - a. Ephesians 2:19-22
    - b. This is not, "all the saved", it is the church that is in Ephesus.

- B. "...which is the church of the living God,..."
  - 1. "Which is" =  $\eta T I S$  = "which indeed".
  - 2. "Church" = ξΚΚλησια = "called out for a purpose".
  - 3. "Living" =  $\zeta \alpha \omega$  = "to live" (God).
  - 4. Is this the universal, invisible church? There is no such church!
  - 5. Statement of Dr. Jimmy Kirkland.
- C. "...the pillar and ground of the truth."
  - 1. "Pillar" =  $\sigma T v \lambda o S = "a column", "a firm support"$
  - 2. "Ground" =  $\epsilon$ δραιωμα = "basis", "foundation", "what is fixed", "settled", "stationary".
  - 3. "Truth" =  $\alpha\lambda\eta\theta\epsilon\iota\alpha\varsigma$  = "the veritable essence".
  - 4. "The support and foundation of the truth".

## II. The Truth As Revealed By The Living God.

- A. Vs 16 "And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness:..."
  - 1. "Controversy" =  $\delta\mu$ 0 $\lambda$ 0 $\gamma$  $\epsilon\nu\mu$  $\epsilon\nu\omega$ S = "by mutual confession", "by common consent".
  - 2. "Mystery" =  $\mu$ υστηριον = "revealed truth".
  - 3. "Godliness" =  $\epsilon \nu \sigma \epsilon \beta \epsilon \iota \alpha$  = "a real, true, vital, relationship with God", "like God".
- B. "...God was manifest in the flesh..."
  - 1. "Manifest" =  $\phi \alpha \nu \epsilon \rho \omega$  = "to make visible".
  - 2. Isaiah 7:14 "Behold, a virgin shall conceive..." Isaiah 9:6 - "For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given..."
  - 3. Matthew 1:23 "...they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us"
  - 4. John 1:14 "...And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we behold his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father) full of grace and truth."
  - 5. "Flesh" =  $\sigma\alpha\rho\xi$  = "the flesh of a man", "corporately".

- C. "...justified in the spirit,..."
  - 1. "Justified" =  $\delta \iota \kappa \alpha \iota o \omega$  = "to declare righteous", "to vindicate".
  - 2. The Holy Spirit vindicated the work of Jesus at His baptism. Matthew 3:15 - "suffer it to be so now: for thus it becometh us to fulfill all righteousness."
  - 3. It vindicated His life at the mount of transfiguration. Mark 9:7 - "This is my beloved son: hear him."
  - 4. He was vindicated as to His holiness when the Spirit raised Him from the dead.
- D. "...seen of angels..."
  - 1. The angels at His birth. Luke 2:9-14
  - 2. Angels ministered to Him. Matt 4:11 "...angels came and ministered to Him."
  - 3. An angel rolled away the stone. Matt 28:2-3 "...for the angel of the lord descended from
    heaven and came and rolled back the stone from the
    door and sat upon it."
- E. "...preached unto the Gentiles..."
  - 1. Paul was called to this task. Acts 9:15
  - Paul was true to his calling. Ephesians 3:7-8 "...that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ."
- F. "...believed on in the world..."
  - 1. Some Jews believed. John 1:11-12
  - 2. Some Gentiles believed. Acts 16:30-31
  - At Berea, "many of them believed" Acts 17:12-14
  - 4. At Thessalonica, "some of them believed"
- G. "...received up into glory."
  - 1. Acts 1:9 "...while they beheld, he was taken up; and a cloud received him out of their sight..."
  - 2. He is seated at God's right hand. Hebrews 9:24 "For Christ is not entered into the holy places
    made with hands, which are the figures of the
    true; but into heaven itself, now to appear in the
    presence of God for us."
