PAUL, A GOOD EXAMPLE

II Timothy 3:10-14

Intro:

- A. We are living in the last days.
 - There are those like the evil men earlier described in this chapter.
 - 2. There are men like Paul.
- B. It is important to have examples.
 - 1. It is difficult to know how to be what we should be by studying concepts only.
 - 2. Jesus is our supreme examples.

I. The Example Of Paul.

- A. Vs 10 "But thou hast fully known my doctrine,..."
 - 1. "Fully known" = $\pi\alpha\rho\alpha\kappao\lambdao\nu\theta\epsilon\omega$ = "to follow closely" This may also describe the relation of a disciple to his master.
 - 2. "Doctrine" = διδασκαλια = "teaching".
 - 3. "...have known intimately" PHI "my teaching"
- B. "...manner of life, purpose, faith,..."
 - 1. "Manner of life" = $\alpha \gamma \omega \gamma \eta$ = "the way one leads his life".
 - 2. "Purpose" = π ροθεσις = "purpose", "guiding motive".
 - 3. "Faith" = $\pi \iota \sigma \tau \circ \varsigma$
- C. "...longsuffering, charity, patience,"
 - 1. "Longsuffering" = μ ακροθυμια = "patient enduring".
 - 2. "Charity" = $\alpha \gamma \alpha \pi \eta$ = "love".
 - 3. "Patience" = $\dot{\nu}\pi o\mu o\nu \eta$ = "bearing under", "patient and hopeful endurance".
 - 4. "My long waiting, my love, my stedfastness" MOF
- D. Vs 11 "Persecutions, afflictions, which came unto me at Antioch, at Iconium, at Lystra;..."

- 1. "Persecutions" = $\delta \iota \omega \gamma \mu \circ \varsigma$ = "pursuit, as of enemies chasing a victim".
- 2. "Afflictions" = $\pi \alpha \theta \eta \mu \alpha$ = "suffering affliction".
- 3. Paul mentions specific locations.

E. "...what persecutions I endured:..."

- 1. "Persecutions" = $\delta \iota \omega \gamma \mu \sigma S =$ "as a hunted one".
- 2. "Endured" = ὑποφερια = "to bear by being under", "to be under and carry a heavy load".

F. "...but out of them all the Lord delivered me."

- 1. "Delivered" = $\dot{\rho}\nu o\mu \alpha \iota$ = "to rescue", "to snatch from danger".
- 2. And the Lord rescued me out of them all.

II. The Inevitable To The Godly. Vs 12

- A. "Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus..."
 - 1. "Yea, and all who wish to live godly" ABUV
 - 2. "...all who have a strong desire to live a godly life", "all who are determined...".

B. "...shall suffer persecution."

- 1. "Suffer persecution" = $\delta \iota \omega \kappa \omega$ = "to cause to flee", "to pursue after".
- 2. "Persecution is inevitable for those who are determined to live really Christian lives" - PHI

III. The Evil Times Will Furnish Opportunity To Suffer Evil.

A. "But evil men and seducers shall wax worse and worse,..." Vs 13a

- 1. "Evil" = π Ονηρος = "causing sorrow and pain".
- 2. "Seducers" = $\gamma \circ \eta \varsigma$ = "one who howls incantations", "one who practices magic art", "swindler", "a cheat".
- 3. " \underline{Wax} " = $\pi\rho OKO\pi T\omega$ = "to drive forward with repeated strokes", "to beat ahead".
- 4. "Worse and worse" = $\in \pi$ 1 TO $\chi \in 100V$ = "upon the road"

- to the worse", "in the direction of the worse".
- 5. "But wicked men and impostors will advance from bad to worse..." CON
- B. "...deceiving, and being deceived."
 - 1. "Deceiving" = $\pi\lambda\alpha\nu\alpha\omega$ = "to lead astray".
 - "misleading others and mislead themselves"

IV. The Course Timothy Should Take.

- A. "But continue thou in the things which thou hast learned..." Vs 14a
 - 1. "Continue" = $\mu \in V\omega$ = "to remain". It means for this to be constant and continual.
 - 2. "Learned" = $\mu \alpha \nu \theta \alpha \nu \omega$ = "to learn".
 - 3. "You must stand in the truths you have learned..."
- B. "...and hast been assured of,..."
 - 1. "Assured" = $\pi \iota \sigma \tau \circ \omega$ = "to make reliable".
 - 2. "and been led to rely upon" WMS
- C. "...knowing of whom thou hast learned them;"
 - 1. "knowing who your teachers were" WEY
 - "well aware from whom you learned"
