

THE LORD WILL STAND WITH YOU

II Timothy 4:16-22

Intro:

- A. Paul had been arrested for preaching Christ and had been imprisoned.
 - 1. Initially, all forsook him.
 - 2. At this writing only Luke was with him.

- B. Paul was aware that the Lord had stood with him
 - 1. Vs 17 - "Notwithstanding, the Lord stood with me..."
 - 2. He was delivered.

- C. The most vital lesson that we learn is that we can depend upon the Lord.
 - 1. He will never leave us, nor forsake us.
 - 2. He can deliver us.
 - 3. Why are you in trouble?

I. Paul's Trial And Burden. Vs 16

- A. "At my first answer no man stood with me..."
 - 1. "Answer" = απολογία = "a speech in defense".
 - 2. "Stood" = παραγινομαι = "to be along side of", "to support", "someone to stand forward in court on the prisoner's behalf".

- B. "...but all men forsook me..."
 - 1. "Forsook" = εγκαταλειπω = "to leave behind".
 - 2. At the first hearing of my case no one came into court to support me" - NEB "On the contrary they all deserted me" - MON

- C. "...I pray God that it may not be laid to their charge."
 - 1. "Charge" = λογιζομαι = "to place to one's account"
 - 2. "May it never be charged to their account" - WMS
 - 3. The prayer of Stephen.
 - 4. The prayer of Jesus.

II. The Presence And The Purpose Of The Lord. Vs 17

- A. "Notwithstanding the Lord stood with me, and strengthened me;..."
1. "Stood" = παριστημι = "to stand by one's side".
 2. "Strengthened" = ενδυναμω = "to empower".
 3. But the Lord stood by me and empowered me
 4. I Corinthians 10:13-14
- B. "...that by me the preaching might be fully known, and that all the Gentiles might hear:..."
1. "Preaching" = κηρυγμα = "proclamation".
 2. "So that through me the news might be given out in full measure" BAS "For the whole pagan world to hear" - NEB
- C. "...and I was delivered out of the mouth of the lion."
1. "Delivered" = ρυομαι = "to rescue", "to draw or snatch for one's self".
 2. "And I was rescued from the jaws of the lion"
 3. Psalms 22:21 - "Save me from the lion's mouth..."
 4. Daniel was "rescued".
 5. As a Roman citizen, Paul would not be offered to the lions as a means of death.

III. The Faith Of Paul In The Lord. Vs 18

- A. "And the Lord shall deliver me from every evil work,..."
1. "Deliver" = ρυομαι = "to rescue".
 2. "Evil" = πονηρος = "active evil", "every kind of evil".
 3. "The Lord will rescue me from every evil plot".
 4. This had been the habit of Paul's life.
 5. II Corinthians 1:8-11
- B. "...and will preserve me unto his heavenly kingdom:..."
1. "Preserve" = σωζω = "to save", "to deliver".
 2. "...and will bring me safe to His heavenly kingdom..."
- C. "...to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen."

1. "To Him be everlasting glory".
2. "Glory be to Him through the ages never ending".

IV. People And A Plea.

- A. Paul recognized the influence of people in his life
 1. **verse 19**
 2. **verse 20**
- B. He needed Timothy.
 1. **verse 21**
 2. We who are preachers need faithful support. We need ministerial companionship.
