Intro. A. This is Retorical question. Do not raise your hand. Do not answer verbally. 11. Have you ever broken the Sabbath? 2. If so why are you still living?

> B. In these verses we Tesus condemned for healing on the Sabbath. Vs.14 11. The Rulen of the Synagogue was angened. 15.17 2. Later His adversaries were ashamed.

## I. Jesus And The Subbath.

A. Jesus went to a synagogue on the sabbath. Vs. 10 11. He not only attended, He taught. 2. "teaching" = Sisaokw = to give instrustion, direct.

B. There was a woman who also attended the synagogue. Vs.11 16 She had a spirit of infinmity. ar devela = "want of strength," feebleness, "sickness." 2. She was bowed together! συγκύπτω = "to bend forward towards each other" ( Probably sevene osteoporosous) 3. She could not straighten up.

C Jesus sawher. Vs.12 11- He called here to Him. 2. He spoke to her, "Woman, thou art loosed from thine infirmity". Vs.13 13. He laid His hands on her. 14. She was immediately made straight. Tapaxpipaa = with the thing itself, at the very moment. 5. She glorified God.

## II. The Power of Divine Wisdom Shown. (2)

A. Sin and error are identified.

Vs.17 11. And when he had said these things, all his

Adversaries were ashamed":

2. "adversaries" = avriveryal = to be placed in

opposition, one who opposes.

13. "ashamed" = aioxivopal = To have the feeling that attends the performance of a dishonourable deed.

B. Rightousness and goodness are glorified.

11."...and all the people Resoiced for all
the glorious things that were done by him".

12. "Resoiced" = xaipw = "to be glad"

13. "glorious = EvSosos = "to recognize anything to be henourable or distinguished."

## I. This was The Sabbath Then. Let US Look At The Sabbath Now.

A. The Law of Moses was given to a nation of people. It regulated every phase of their lives.

12. The Sahbath was a part of this system.

\* B. All other nations were under God but were guided by <u>conscience</u>.

11. They were not regulated by <u>Moses's law</u>.

12. Romans 2:11-15
3. This did not excuse them from

God's Ludgment. They were accountable to Him.
