11. This is a part of the heretical "Prosperity Gospel."

12. Paul did say, Phil. 4:6-"Be careful for nothing: but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanks-giving let your requests be made known unto God".

13. This is een by some as a "blank check".

B. James and John made a Request to Jesus.

15. 35 11. desire = ETILDUMÍA = a longing, gearning,

denotes inward passion and mental desire.

12. ... We want you to grant us a special request.

Matt. 20:20 3. Their Mother was involved in this request.

VS.36 11. "What would ye that I should do for you"?

12. "What do you want me to do"?

## I. James And John Specify Their Request.

Vs. 37 A. "They said unto him, Grant unto us... = SiSwar to give, present, to give freely unforced, to gield, commit 11." that we may sit, one on thy right hand, and the other on thy left hand.

13. Why this Request? They had been with Him on the mount of transfiguration. 9:1-10

14. They knew that seeing Him on the mount had something to do with His statement about Rising

from the dead. Vs. 31, 9:10



B. The ideal attitude.

Vs.436 11."... whosoever will be great among you,

Shall be your minister". Siakovos = "an attendant,"
"waiter at a table" "to give service to another"

This is not a capital "M."!

V5. 44 2." And whosoever of you will be the chiefest, shall be servant of all".

3. "Chiefest" = TPWTOS = the first, foremost 4. "Servant" = Sounds = a slave, one bound to serve, one whose will and abilities are wholly at the service of another.

C. The mission and example of Jesus. Vs.45 11. Jesus did not come to be waited on by slaves and flunkies. He came to serve Fod.

2. "Ransom" = LUTPOV = "the price paid for letting loose or setting free".
