 - 1. "...came unto Him as he was teaching..." v.23
 - 2. They were distraught by all the things that Jesus had done. He had returned from Bethany.
- B. They asked Him two questions.
 - 1. "By what authority doest thou these things"?
 - 2. "Who gave thee this authority"?
 - 3. $\underline{\text{authority}} = \epsilon \xi o \nu \sigma i \alpha = \text{delegated power,}$ authority to do anything; permission, license
- C. What "things" do they mean?
 - 1. The triumphal entry as a king.
 - 2. The cleansing of the temple.
 - The children crying in the temple.
- I. The Answer Of Jesus.
 - A. Jesus proposed trading information. V.24
 - 1. "I also will ask you one thing..."
 - 2. "I in likewise will tell you..."
 - B. The information Jesus sought. V.25
 - 1. "The baptism of John, whence was it?"
 - 2. "from heaven or of men?"
- II. The Dilemma Of The Chief Priests And Elders.
 - A. "...And they reasoned with themselves, saying..." v.25a
 - 1. reasoned = διαλογιζομαι = "to think through"
 - 2. "...if we shall say, From heaven..."
 - 3. "...he will say...Why did ye not believe him?"
 - 4. "But if we shall say, of men; We fear the people for all hold John as a prophet" v.26
 - 5. And they answered Jesus, and said, We cannot tell." V.27a
 - B. Jesus stands His ground.

- 1. "Neither tell I you by what authority..." v.27b.
- 2. Jesus knew their hearts.

- A. the parable of the two sons.
 - 1. "But what think ye"? v.28-30
 - 2. Think about this, form an opinion.
 - 3. "Whether of them twain did the will of his father"? v.31
 - 4. "They say unto him, The first."
- B. The application of the parable.
 - 1. This is not Jew and Gentile.
 - 2. The publican and the harlots where the ones who repented and entered the kingdom.
- C. The chief priests and elders would not accept authoritative information.
 - 1. $\frac{\text{righteousness}}{\text{doing what is just and right: } \mathbf{v.32}}$
 - 2. The religious leaders were saying, we are doing God's work but they weren't. When they heard and saw authoritative figures they would not repent and enter His vineyard.
