- 4. $\underline{\text{teach}} = \mu \alpha \theta \eta \tau \epsilon \upsilon \omega = \text{``to disciple,'' ``to make a disciple,'' ``to train as a disciple.''}$
- 5. nations = $\varepsilon\theta vos$ = "the Gentile nations."

E. The disciples are to be baptized.

- 1. They must be believers. V.19b
- 2. They must be immersed.

F. They must also be taught.

- 1. $\underline{\text{teaching}} = \delta \imath \delta \alpha \sigma \kappa \omega = \text{``to teach,'' 'to give instruction'' 'to give direction'' v.20a}$
- 2. <u>commanded</u> = εντελλομαι = "to enjoin upon," "to charge with."
