 - 1. "...thy disciples transgress the tradition of the elders" v.2
 - 2. "...they wash not their hands when they eat bread."
- B. Jesus taught them the truth.
 - "These are the things which defile a man:"
 v.20
 - 2. "...to eat with unwashen hands defileth not a man..."
- I. Jesus States The Principle.
 - A. "And he called the multitude, and said unto them, hear and understand."
 - 1. $\frac{\text{called}}{\text{v.10}} = \pi \rho o \sigma \kappa \alpha \lambda \epsilon \omega = \text{``to call to one's self''}$
 - 2. <u>understand</u> = συνιημι = "to comprehend."
 - B. What defileth a man? V.11
 - 1. "...not that which goeth into the mouth..."
 - 2. "...but that which cometh out of the mouth..."
 - 3. $\frac{\text{defileth}}{\text{common ceremonially, hence to defile.}}$ "to make

II. The Truth Offends.

- A. "then came his disciples and said unto him, knowest thou that the Pharisees were offended, after they heard this saying? V.12
 - 1. "Are you aware..." Ber.
 - 2. $\underline{\text{offended}} = \sigma \kappa \alpha \nu \delta \alpha \lambda i \zeta \omega = \text{``to cause to stumble''}$ to cause deep religious offense at Jesus' teaching.

 - 1. The truth about God...

 - 2. Let them alone = "Let them talk..." v.14
 - 3. They are blind, they lead the blind.
 - 4. They shall all fall in the ditch.

 - 1. declare = $\phi \rho \alpha \zeta \omega$ = "to interpret"
 - 2. "Explain completely this illustration."
 - B. The process of eating and digestion. V.16-17
 - 1. That which is eaten goes to the belly.
 - 2. It does not go to the heart.
 - 3. It goes to the latrine.
- IV. That Which Truly Defiles A Man.
 - A. That which comes up truly defiles. V.18
 - 1. They proceed out of the mouth.
 - 2. They defile the man.
 - B. That which comes from the heart.
 - 1. evil thoughts, murders, adulteries... v.19
 - 2. fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies.
 - C. Jesus settles the issue.
 - 1. "These are the things..." V.20
 - 2. "to eat with unwashen hands do not..."
