 - 2. 17:3, "he carried me away in the Spirit."
 - 3. 21:10, "he carried me away in the Spirit."
- II. JOHN NOT ONLY SAW, HE HEARD. V10
 - A. John's commission.
 - 1. 10,11, "What thou seest, write in a book."
 - 2. "send unto the seven churches in Asia."
 - B. We have a commission.
 - 1. We expect John to have been faithful.
 - 2. We should be faithful.
- III. JOHN'S VISION OF JESUS. V12-16
 - A. John's description of Jesus.

 - 2. Not what the shepherds saw!
 - B. The mystery he saw.
 - 1. Seven Candlesticks. v12.
 - Seven stars. v16.
 - C. The character of Jesus. v16.
 - "out of his mouth went a sharp two edged sword."
 a. Heb. 4:12.
 - "his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength."
 - a. Churches are lamps, Pastors are Stars, and Christ is the Sun.

IV. JOHN'S FRIGHT AT THIS VISION. V17

- A. "And when I saw him I fell at His feet as dead."
 - The sight of His majesty!
 - 2. Silent, unmoving, shaken.
- B. Men continually respond in this manner if they have understanding.
 - 1. There is no better place for man.
 - This should lay aside the moder theory of being a "buddy" to Jesus.
 - John didn't command Jesus to bless him, Kenneth Copeland, Jimmy Swaggert, Shuler, etc.
- V. THE ASSURANCE OF JESUS. V17b,18
 - A. "Fear not, I am the first and the last."
 - 1. There is no fear in perfect love.
 - 2. He is from time to time.
 - B. "I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore."

- 1. Jesus literally died on the cross.
- 2. He will never die again!
- C. "Amen. and have the keys of hell and of death."
 - Keys are symbols of authority.
 - Jesus has authority over death as a process and the grace, its end.
