 - 1. opened = anoigo to open, to stand open.
 - 2. same as B. # 2,3.

 - a. furnace = kaminos = an oven or kiln.
 - b. great =

 - scorpions = skorpios = A lobster-like vermin some four or five inches long, it had a claw on the end of the tail that secreted a poison when it struck.
 - 3. They had the power, not the appearance, of locusts.
 - B. Their limitations. v4-5
 - commanded = hreo to say, God spoke to them His mind and His will.
 - 2. hurt = adikeo -= to wrong, to injure.
 - 3. "have not the seal of God."
 - 4. "should not kill them," the others on earth.
 - 5. torment = basanos examination by trial, enquiry by torture, torture, pain.
 - stricketh = paio to strike, to smite.
 - C. Their shape. v7.
 - shapes = homoioma something made like, a likeness, shape, implying resemblance.
 - 2. They were armoured. He saw mens faces.
 - D. Their hair, and their teeth. v8.
 - "hair, as the hair of women." long.
 - 2. "teeth, as the teeth of lions.: strong.
 - E. Their breastplates. v9
 - 1. "breastplates of iron."
 - 2. Had the appearance of mail.

 - desire = epithumeo to long for, to desire earnestly.
