 - 3. Paul selected a place to rest,
 - 4. Nicopolis = "victory city in Greece."
 - a. A winter resort.
 - C. Zenas and Apollos.
 - 1. Zenas = Roman law or Mosiac.
 - 2. Apollos = powerful preacher.
 - 3. Diligently = earnestly, speedily.
 - 4. See that they want for nothing.
 - D. God's men are to have all their needs meet.
 - 1. I Cor. 9:7.
