

LESSON TEXT: GENESIS 6: 5-8, 12-14, 17-19
7: 7-10

LESSON MATERIAL: NOAH AND THE ARK

NOAH WAS A GOOD MAN WHO OBEYED GOD. NOAH DID WHAT GOD TOLD HIM TO DO. GOD LOVED NOAH VERY MUCH.

GOD SAW THAT THE OTHER MEN AND LADIES WERE VERY BAD, THE OTHER MEN AND LADIES WERE VERY EVIL.

GOD SAID, "I WILL DESTROY MAN — I WILL DESTROY ALL THE PEOPLE AND ALL THE ANIMALS", EXCEPT GOD DID NOT DESTROY NOAH AND HIS FAMILY. GOD WAS MERCIFUL TO NOAH.

GOD TOLD NOAH HE WOULD BRING A BIG FLOOD — A FLOOD TO DESTROY THE PEOPLE AND THE ANIMALS AND THE EARTH.

GOD TOLD NOAH TO BUILD AN ARK — A BIG BOAT. GOD TOLD NOAH THAT GOD WOULD TAKE CARE OF NOAH AND HIS FAMILY. GOD TOLD NOAH AND HIS FAMILY TO GET IN THE ARK (THE BIG BOAT), AND TO TAKE ANIMALS INTO THE ARK.

NOAH AND HIS FAMILY AND THE ANIMALS WENT INTO THE ARK AND GOD TOOK CARE OF THEM.

MEMORY VERSE: "MAKE THEE AN ARK"

GENESIS 6:14

LESSON TEXT: GENESIS 7:17-18, 20, 24
8:1-4

LESSON MATERIAL: THE FLOOD

THE FLOOD CAME UPON THE EARTH FOR FORTY DAYS. THERE WAS MORE AND MORE WATER ON THE EARTH. THE ARK FLOATED ON TOP OF THE WATER. THERE WAS SO MUCH WATER THAT THE MOUNTAINS WERE COVERED WITH WATER.

GOD REMEMBERED NOAH AND HIS FAMILY AND ALL THE ANIMALS IN THE ARK. GOD MADE A WIND BLOW OVER THE EARTH AND THE WATER WENT BACK DOWN.

WHEN THE WATER WENT BACK DOWN, THE ARK WAS SITTING ON TOP OF A MOUNTAIN.

MEMORY VERSE: "GOD REMEMBERED NOAH."
GENESIS 8:1

LESSON TEXT: GENESIS 8: 6-13

LESSON MATERIAL: THE BIRDS WENT FORTH

AFTER THE ARK WAS ON TOP OF THE MOUNTAIN FOR FORTY DAYS, NOAH OPENED THE WINDOW OF THE ARK AND SENT A BIRD (A RAVEN). ALSO, NOAH SENT A BIRD CALLED A DOVE. NOAH SENT THE DOVE BECAUSE NOAH KNEW THAT IF THE DOVE CAME BACK TO THE ARK IT WOULD MEAN ALL THE GROUND WAS STILL WET AND MUDDY. NOAH WANTED TO KNOW IF THE WATER HAD DRIED UP OFF THE GROUND.

THE DOVE CAME BACK TO THE ARK BECAUSE THE WATER WAS STILL ON THE GROUND.

AFTER SEVEN MORE DAYS, NOAH SENT THE DOVE OUT THE WINDOW AGAIN. THAT NIGHT THE DOVE CAME BACK TO THE ARK AND BROUGHT AN OLIVE LEAF. THEN NOAH KNEW THE WATER HAD ^{STARTED TO} DRY UP OFF THE GROUND.

AFTER SEVEN MORE DAYS, NOAH SENT THE DOVE OUT THE WINDOW AGAIN. THAT TIME THE DOVE DID NOT COME BACK.

THE WATER HAD DRIED UP FROM OFF THE GROUND. NOAH TOOK THE COVERING OFF THE ARK AND SAW THE GROUND WAS DRY.

MEMORY VERSE: "THE GROUND WAS DRY"

GENESIS 8:13

LESSON TEXT: GENESIS 8:15-20

LESSON MATERIAL: THEY THANKED GOD

AFTER THE WATER DRIED UP AND THE FLOOD WAS ALL GONE, GOD TOLD NOAH TO TAKE HIS FAMILY AND GO OUT OF THE ARK. GOD ALSO TOLD NOAH TO BRING ALL OF THE ANIMALS OUT OF THE ARK.

NOAH, AND HIS FAMILY, AND ALL OF THE ANIMALS CAME OUT OF THE ARK.

THE FIRST THING NOAH DID, WHEN THEY CAME OUT OF THE ARK, WAS BUILD AN ALTAR FOR GOD. NOAH THANKED GOD FOR TAKING CARE OF THEM.

MEMORY VERSE: "NOAH BUILT AN ALTAR"
GENESIS 8:20

LESSON TEXT: GENESIS 9:8-17

LESSON MATERIAL: RAINBOWS IN THE SKY

AFTER THE FLOOD, GOD TOLD NOAH AND NOAH'S SONS, "I MAKE MY COVENANT WITH YOU AND ALL YOUR CHILDREN AFTER YOU." (A COVENANT IS A PROMISE FROM GOD THAT WILL ALWAYS BE TRUE.)

GOD TOLD NOAH, "I MAKE MY COVENANT WITH YOU; THE PEOPLE AND THE ANIMALS WILL NEVER AGAIN BE ALL DESTROYED BY A FLOOD.

GOD SAID, "THIS IS THE SIGN OF THE COVENANT BETWEEN US.... I WILL PUT MY RAINBOW IN THE SKY." WHEN GOD PUTS A RAINBOW IN THE SKY HE REMEMBERS THE COVENANT BETWEEN GOD AND THE PEOPLE AND THE ANIMALS AND ALL LIVING THINGS.

MEMORY VERSE! "I DO SET MY BOW IN THE CLOUD." (GENESIS 9:13)
