I. Introduction

\* A. Obedying means following the commandments or leadership and direction of another

\* B. Obedying is very important to God.

## II. Example of Jonah

- A. God gave Jonah a commandment to obey immediately. (Jonah 1:1-2)
- B. Jonah tried to run away and just ignore the job God assigned to him (Jonah 1:3-5)
- C. Jonah's lack of obedience caused difficulties & dangers for himself & others (Jonah 1:6-17)
- D. Jonah turned to God in the midst of his difficulties. (Jonah 2:1-9)  
(acknowledged God's power & authority)  
sought forgiveness
- E. God delivered Jonah from the punishment. (Jonah 2:10)
- F. God gave Jonah a second chance, but the commandment did not change (Jonah 3:1-2)
- G. Jonah obeyed immediately & exactly. (Jonah 3:3-4)

H. Jonah's obedience brought out the results God had planned. (Jonah 3:5-10)

III. Saying is one thing — doing is what God wants & expects.

A. Obeying your parents & obeying the Bible is what God expects of you. (Fathers & mothers lead. Children obey.)

1. Obeying helps you develop into a responsible person.

2. Obeying helps you learn to control yourself & develop into a settled, trustworthy person. (the kind of person God can use.)

3. God has spoken thru the Bible, we should listen & obey.
