Introduction:

- A. Christianity is more than a doctrine.
 - Many who are dogmatic in belief and without conviction about life.
 - 2. Conversion is an experience and a doctrine.
- B. Peter wanted these people to keep in mind, both sides of Christianity.
 - 1. O.T. prophecy, doctrine. = 1:10-
 - Now live your life with His mind because you have done enough wrong. v
- I. ARM YOURSELF WITH THE SAME MIND AS CHRIST.
 - A. Christ suffered for us in the flesh.
 - 1. v3:18.
 - 2. This was to redeem us.
 - B. We shall suffer in the flesh. v1 Get ready for the same experiences.
 - a. arm = to prepare, get your mind right.
 - It is absurd to expect to be free from the problems of life because you are a Christian.
 - C. The suffering Christian, like the suffering Christ, has a different attitude about sin.
 - 1. v1,2 = "desire to be a sinner has ceased."
 - 2. Rom. 6:2,7.
 - 3. Gal. 5:24.
 - We do not want to live in the flesh, but to do the will of God.

II. WE HAVE DONE ENOUGH WRONG. V3

- A. "The time past of our life."
 - suffice = to be sufficient.
- B. "when we walked" leading our lives.
 - in lasciviousness = steeped in sensuality.
 - 2. lusts = lustful desires.
 - excess of wine = getting drunk.
 - revellings = wild parties.
 - 5. banquetings = drinking bouts.
 - abominable idolatries = worship of idols.

III. THE WORLD WILL NOT UNDERSTAND. V4

- A. They think it strange.
 - 1. Are astonished = former friends.
 - "violent wasting of life."
- B. "speaking evil of you."
 - *malign and verbally abuse you.*
- IV. THE WORLD WILL BE JUDGED. V5,6
 - A. v 5 = God will judge all things!
 - 1. Living and dead.
 - B. v 6 = The gospel is the basis of eternal judgment.
- V. THINGS WON'T GO ON THIS WAY. UT
 - A. Things won't keep on like they are.
 - B. Therefore, be honest, thoughtful men of prayer.
