#### Introduction:

- A. Sometimes we do not look as closely as we should at the last few lines of a letter.
  - Tired of trying to decide what to do with the first problems.
- B. These three verses have some great truths.
  - 1. Just as true as first three verses.
- I. GOD USES FAITHFUL PEOPLE. V12a
  - A. Peter judges him to be faithful.
    - 1. "whom I know to be a faithful brother."
    - faithful = worthy of confidence, persons of whom we can rely.
  - B. Paul acknowledged him as faithful.
    - 1. II Cor. 1:18-20.
  - C. A person who cannot be depended on is a thorn and a source of grief.
    - 1. faithful = is "all the time"
    - 2. Some are faithfully unfaithful.
- II. THESE PEOPLE WERE STANDING IN "TRUE GRACE." V12b
  - A. "I have written you this short letter to encourage you and to bear testimony, that the grace in which you are so firmly established is the true grace of God."
    - 1. Everyone is standing (depending) on something.
    - 2. Drunkard, liar, cheat.
  - B. The devil is an imitator.
    - 1. He has false prophets.

- 2. They preach a false gospel.
- Those who accept a false gospel, stand in a false grace with a false hope.

## III. THERE WERE OTHER TRUE CONGREGATIONS. V13

- A. This is a comforting fact.
  - Woe is the congregation that believes themselves to be alone in the service to God.
- B. We seek to build churches in other places of the world.
  - 1. We do not seek to dominate them, only help.

#### IV. SHOW LOVE FOR ONE ANOTHER. V14

- A. greet = to salute, to embrace and part.
  - 1. An absurdity that brothers in Christ do not speak.
  - 2. An indication of a persons true character.
  - 3. Should be a quite and sincere greeting.
- B. peace the absence or end of strife.
  - 1. By no means the least important of Christian graces
