THE SALVATION OF YOUR SOULS I Peter 1:9-12

Introduction:

- A. The recipients of this letter were "faith people."
 - 1. vs. 7.
 - 2. vs. 9 "while you reap the harvest of your faith, that is, the salvation of your souls."
- B. Faith is the basis for action.
 - 1. Without faith any activity is invalid.
 - a. "without faith it is impossible to please God."
 - 2. Without activity, faith is invalidated.
 - a. "faith without works is dead."

I. SEARCHING

- A. "the prophets have inquired and searched diligently,"
 - inquired = to look into.
 - searched = to trace out, to search by uncovering, to search minutely.
 - "diligently = speedily, earnestly, eagerly.
- B. "who prophesied of the grace that should come unto us."
 - 1. Jesus is a New Testament name but an Old Testament character.
 - 2. They knew his character, but not his name!
- C. These prophets did not seek salvation but when would the prophecies would come true.
 - 1. They wanted to be living to see Him.
- D. The before-hand testimonies of the suffering Christ.
 - 1. "the spirit of Christ, which was in them."
 - a. O.T. saints,
 - b. Indwelling of spirit.
 - 2. Isaiah 53:3-

II. THE REVELATION. VS. 12

- A. "unto whom it was revealed, that not unto themselves, but unto us, they did minister the things."
 - 1. The time was not then.
 - 2. They died in faith, not having received the promise.
- B. We must not be a "waiting" people, but a waiting, watching, working people.
