III. "PASS THE TIME OF YOUR SOJOURNING HERE IN FEAR."

- A. "pass the time" = "during the time of your stay on this earth."
 - 1. You can't cross a river but once.
 - 2. You don't get a second chance.
- B. sojourning = dwelling beside or near, residence in a foreign land without the rights of citizenship.
- C. fear = reverence, "Let reverence be the spirit of your lives."
 - 1. "fear God and Keep His commandments."
 - 2. Beware when you loose your reverence for God!
