 - 1. Parable of Tares.
 - 2. The tares are false churches.
- D. Paul warned of false Apostles.
 - II Cor. 11:13 "But such are false apostles, deceitful workers, transfroming themselves into the Apostles of Christ."

I. WHAT IS THE "DOCTRINE OF CHRIST"?

- A. The specific doctrine of God incarnate in Jesus Christ.
 - 1. vs. 7
 - "I and my Father are one." John 10:30.
 - 3. "If you have the Son, you have the Father."
- B. "whosoever transgresseth, and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ, hath not God."
 - transgresseth = to go before, to run ahead. Goes
 beyond the limits of the teaching of Christ.
 Teachers who offered to take them deeper into God's
 Word.
 - abideth not = not remaining.

- C. "He that abideth in the doctrine of Christ, he hath both the Father and the Son."
 - abideth = remaining.
 - doctrine = teaching, process of teaching, to thing taught.

II. HOW TO TREAT TEACHERS OF FALSE DOCTRINE. VS. 10

- A. False teachers will come.
 - "If there come any unto you, and bring not this doctrine."
 - 2. "If you are visited by one..."
- B. The command of John.
 - 1. "receive him not into your house."
 - a. receive. = to take hold of.
 - b. house = the home.
 - 2. "neither bid him God speed."
 - a. bid = to speak, to say.
 - b. speed = to wish joy, rejoice, be glad.

III. THE REASON FOR SUCH ACTION. VS. 11

- A. "for he that biddeth him God speed is partaker of his evil deeds."
 - 1. partaker = to share in common.
 - 2. III John 5-8
