  - 1. Apostle.
  - 2. Lived through a persecution.
  - 3. Write Revelation, Gospel, I John in that order.
    - a. In His Gospel he presents way of salvation.
    - b. Epistle, how to know you are a Christian and how to enjoy our Christianity.

## I. THE ETERNITY OF CHRIST.

- A. One of primary sources of joy is security.
  - Child that is insecure in parent's love is unhappy.
  - 2. Factor of unhappiness of aged is insecurity.
- B. Security must be anchored in something that is stable.
  - One insurance company represents its stability by a picture of the Rock of Gibraltor.

- C. The Christian's faith must be anchored in something stable.
  - 1. "That which was from the beginning..."
  - In the beginning Gen. 1:1 Christ was there.
    - a. God said, "Let us make man"
    - b. John 1:1

"In the beginning was the word, and the word was with God, and the word was God."

3. Psalm 90:2.

- B. John had his problem with the Gnostics.
  - Cerentenian, which said God adopted Jesus at his baptism. That Holy Spirit endowed Him then and left Him at the cross.
  - Dosetic, denied the humanity of Jesus, said he was only a ghost type.
  - John says not so, For we have seen and handled him.
- C. Jesus after his resurrection had a body that could be felt.
  - 1. Mary clung to him.

- 2. Thomas saw the scars.
- D. One of the cardinal doctrines is in a bodily, visible return of our Lord.
- E. There are those who would prevent this teaching, yet it is Biblical.
  - Mary Baker Eddy. Yes, I believe the Bible but let's add my little book of Science and Health. That denies the reality of sin.
    - a. Hell is a mortal belief, evil, lust, remorse, etc.
    - Baptism not a ceremony but a spiritual experience a purification from all evil.
    - c. Disease a mental concept.
  - 2. Mormonist, ith its Book of Mormon.
  - 3. Jehovah Witness, with their new interpretations
  - 4. It is no wonder people are confused. John on more than one occasion says, "These are written that ye might know."
  - Yes, Jesus is eternal for he is God, yet he came in the likeness of men.
