 - 1. vs. 19 "They went out from us."
 - 2. vs. ... "they went out."
- B. The leaders of this movement were men who were doctrinally unsound.
 - 1. They denied that Jesus is the Christ. vs.22
 - 2. They denied the Son. vs.23
- C. These leaders lessened the moral and ethical standards of Christ.
 - 1. "love not the world.." 15,16,17.
 - Those who do less than Jesus taught always excuse themselves and all others.
 - 3. Luke 14:25-35.
- D. The "other part" of the church had been seduced by these false teachers.
 - 1. vs.26
 - 2. "seduce" = to make to wander, to lead astray.
 - Webster: "seduce" = to persuade to disobedience or disloyalty.
 - Other places it is used in the N.T.
 - a. Mark 13:21-28.
 - b. Rev. 2:20.
