I. HEAVEN WILL REJOICE. V20

- A. "Rejoice over her, thou heaven, and ye holy apostles and prophets."
 - 1. rejoice = euphraino to make glad-minded.
 - 2. N.T. apostles = The twelve, their messages, true!
 - 3. 0.T. prophets = prophetes one who speaks forth.
- B. "for God hath avenged you on her."
 - avenged = krima to judge judgment, to carry out what has been determined in judgment.
 - 2. Rom. 12:19-

II. AN ILLUSTRATION OF BABYLON'S DESTRUCTION. V21

- A. "And a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone, and cast it into the sea saying, thus with violence shall that great city Babylon be thrown down, and shall be found no more at all."
 - violence = hormema with a rush, like a stone whizzing through the air.
 - 2. The city disappears in one hour.

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3. One day the sun rises as it always has, the stock market opens, the trading begins, all things are prospering, at sunset, everything is gone but the smoke of her burning.

III. THE TOTALITY OF BABYLON'S DESTRUCTION. V22,23

- A. All vestiges of civilization are destroyed.
 - 1. There will be no more music.
 - 2. No more men of skill and trades.
 - 3. No more shops will open.
- B. v23, All signs of domestic life will end.
 - 1. There will be no homes.
 - 2. No more families.
- C. The leaders made wrong decisions.
 - "for thy merchants were the great men of the earth."
 - "for by thy sorceries were all nations deceived."
 - a. sorceries = pharmakeia the preparing or using of medicine, the using of any kinds of drugs, potions or spells.
 - b. deceived = planao to make to wander, cause to err, lead astray, used of religious deceit.

IV. THE SHAME OF BABYLON, V24

- A. There are many things not found in the city of Babylon.
 - 1. Truth, Integrity, Godliness, Purity.
- B. The true work of God is not found.
 - 1. No true churches where the gospel is preached.
 - 2. No Bible study, No hymns about the blood.
- C. The unseen treasure.
 - 1. "And in her was found the blood of prophets, and of saints, and of all that were slain upon the earth."

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- found = heurisko to find, as without seeking, to light upon, to discover.
- 3. slain = Katasphazo to slaughter down, to butcher.
- 4. The blood of the victims accused it!
- V. THE PROPHECY OF JEREMIAH. Jer. 51:1.
 - A. There are several prophecies of doom directed at Babylon
 - 1. Isaiah 13:1-; 14:1-23; 21:1-10.
 - 2. Jer. 51:1- [739 B.C.]
 - B. Prophecy may require a double fulfillment.
 - Once literally in history and another time by the direct intervention of God.
 - 2. This may be true of Babylon.
 - Babylon has been destroyed by invading armies.
 - 4. It may be rebuilt as a defiant act by Antichrist.
 - The tower was built in defiance of God and His commands.

 - 2. It is a time of divine vengeance, v6
 - 3. Babylon is a golden cup. v7
 - 4. Her judgment reaches to heaven. v9
 - 5. It is a wealthy city, v13

 - 7. It is the time of harvest. v33
 - 8. No one may live there, v37
 - 9. Satan will be punished there. v44,47
 - 10. Destroyed a great voice, v55
 - 11. Babylon will sink. v63,64, Rev. 18:21.
