THE FINAL DWELLING PLACE OF THE REDEEMED REV. 21:1-8

Introduction:

- A. The saved dead are not in their final dwelling place.
 - 1. They are at this time in Paradise. Luke 24:42-43, "And he said unto Jesus, Lord, remember me when thou comest into thy kingdom. And Jesus said unto him, Today shalt thou be with me in Paradise."
 - 2. paradise = paradeisos The Septouagint uses it to describe the garden of Eden. A large pleasure-park, with a garden, of an eastern monarch.
- B. Much lies between us and our final home.
 - 1. Death, then the resurrection of our bodies.
 - 2. Rapture, then our instant metamorphosis.
 - 3. Judgment Seat of Christ.
 - 4. The 1,000 year reign of Christ and His saints.
 - 5. What will this final place be?

I. THERE WILL BE A NEW HEAVEN AND A NEW EARTH. VI

- A. "And I saw a new heaven and a new earth."
 - 1. New = Kainos = new, newly made: not merely recent, but different from that which had been formerly; new as coming in the place of a thing that was formerly, and as not yet used.
 - 2. heaven = ouranos the over-arching and the all embracing heaven beneath which is the earth and all thereon.
 - 3. earth = ge the earth, land, as cultivated.
- B. "for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea."
 - 1. first = protos first, the first in time and place.
 - passed away = aperchoma: to go away, to depart.
 - 3. II Peter 3:10-13.

4. God does not tell us why there is no sea. Since the earth was originally watered with a great dew, perhaps this one will to end there won't be the process of evaporation and condensation.

II. A NEW WORLD CAPITOL. U2

- A. "And I John saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven."
 - holy = hagian | city = polin.
 - coming down = Katabaino to descend.
- B. "prepared as a bride adorned for her husband."
 - 1. prepared = etoimazo to make ready. The perfect passive participle indicated, "to have been prepared, and to stand ready." Same word in John 14:2-3, "I go to prepare a place for you," "and if I go and prepared a place for you I will come again and will receive you unto myself, that where I am, there ye may be also."
 - 2. adorned = kosmeo to set in order, prepare.
 - 3. Not the same as Babylon! Decked, Rev. 17:4.

III. A NEW PRESENCE. V3

- A. "And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men," "...and he shall dwell with them."
 - tabernacle = skene any covered, sheltered place, a tent.
 - 2. The tabernacle of God is set up among men."
 - 3. dwell = skenoo to remain, to dwell, to stay in a tent, God sets up His place of dwelling and then He dwells in it. God come to live on the new earth.
- 3. "and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God."

- 1. We have never had it thus before!
- In Eden, Adam and Eve, "heard the voice of the Lord God."

IV. A NEW ORDER. V4

- A. "And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes."
 - 1. wipe = eksaleipho to smear out, to wipe away.
 - tears = dakruon tears, every single tear.
 - 3. This happens after judgment and 1,000 year reign.
- B. "and there shall be no more death."
 - death = thanatos = the natural end of life.
 - 2. It is truly, everlasting, eternal, life!
- C. "neither sorrow, nor crying."
 - sorrow = penthos mourning.
 - crying = Krauge = crying in grief or in anxiety, outcry, shouting in grief and sorrow.
- D. "neither shall there be any more pain."
 - pain = ponos !abour, travail, hence sorrow, pain, or anguish.
- E. "for the former things are passed away."
 - 1. former = protos the first.
 - passed away = aperchoma: depart, go away.

V. THE GUARANTEE OF THIS NEW PLACE. V5,6a

- A. "And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new."
 - 1. I make all things new.
 - 2. New = kainos =- newly made, something not yet used.
- B. "And he said unto me, Write, for these words are true and faithful."

- 1. write = grapho to grave or cut in.
- true = alethinos that which has truth for its base
- faithful = pistos = worthy of confidence.
- C. "And he said unto me, It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end."
 - 1. It is done = gegonan It has occurred.
 - 2. They have come to pass.

VI. AN INVITATION TO THIS NEW PLACE, 66,7.

- A. Those who have drunk at the fountain.
 - "I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of life freely."
 - 2. athirst = dipsao to be thirsty.
 - fountain = pege spring of [sees] life.
 - 4. freely = dorean freely, without cost.
- B. The invitation of Jesus earlier.
 - John 7:37-39, "If any man thirst, let him come unto me and drink."
 - 2. Rev. 22:17, "And the Spirit and the Bride...."
 - 3. Isaiah 55:1, "Ho, every one that thirsteth, come ye to the waters, and he that hath no money; come ye buy, and eat, yea, come, buy wine, and milk without money and without price."
- C. Those who have overcome. v7
 - "He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son."
 - overcometh = nikao to be victorious.
 - 3. inherit = kleronomeo to be a receiver of a portion, to receive a share of an estate.

VII. THOSE WHO WON'T BE THERE. V8

A. "But the fearful and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers."

- fearful = deilos = cowardly, timid, especially the inward sensation of fear.
- unbelieving = apistos = disbelieving, distrustful, faithless.
- abominable = bdelusomai = to turn away through loathing or disgust.
- 4. murderers = phoneus = murderer.
- B. "and whore mongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars."
 - whoremongers = pornos = a sodomite, one who practices sexual immorality.
 - sorcerers = pharmakos = one who mixes and uses drugs which were used in magic practices.
 - idolaters = eidololates one who worships idois.
 - 4. liars = pseudes false, deceiving, lying.
- C. "shail have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone."
 - 1. part = meros = part, part of a whole, a portion.
 - 2. burneth = Kaio to be lighted, to burn.
 - 3. fire and brimstone.
- D. "this is the second death."
 - second = deuteros second, of number, order, place or time.
 - 2. death = thanatos -= the natural end of man.
 - 3. This is the final, eternal separation.

VIII. HOW TO HAVE THE HOPE OF DWELLING IN THIS PLACE.

- A. You must believe that God is.
- B. You must believe that God has revealed Himself.
- C. You must accept God's provision.
