  - A. His right to this role. v11. TWO THINGS:
    - 1. He is "faithful and true."
    - 2. He makes war in righteousness.
  - B. His appearance, v12,13.
    - 1. His eyes behold all things.
    - 2. He wears many crowns.
    - 3. He bears a special name.
    - 4. His vesture is bloody, not His but His enemies.
    - 5. He is the embodiment of God's Word.
  - C. He has an army, vi4.
    - 1. armies = strateuma an armament, a host.
    - 2. They have uniforms, same as bride's.
  - D. He has a special weapon. v15.
    - 1. A sharp sword.
    - 2. The mission.
  - E. He has a special title, vió.

- 1. vesture = himatsmos clothing, a mantle.
- 2. thigh = meros the thigh.
- II. AN INVITATION TO SUPPER. V17,18.
  - A. The invitation to scavenging fowl. v17
    - fowls = orneon a bird, generally carnivorous.
    - supper = deipnon a meal. (same as v9).
  - B. The angel announces the menu. v18
    - flesh = sarks flesh, the outward is m of human nature.
    - 2. Note the descending order of flesh.
- III. THE OPPOSING ARMY, AND ITS DESTRUCTION.
  - A. The beast and his army, v19
    - 1. This is the battle of Armageddon.
    - 2. Rev. 14:20.
  - B. The fate of Antichrist and His spirit. v20
    - 1. The beast, the Antichrist.
    - The false prophet, a pseudo spirit.
  - C. The slaying of the remnant. v21
    - 1. remnant = loipos = leftovers, the remaining.
    - 2. "flaming turkey wings."
- IV. THIS IS WHERE THE WORLD IS HEADED.
  - A. To defeat!
  - B. To Hell!

## THE BINDING OF SATAN AND RESULTING PEACE REV. 20:1-6

## Introduction:

- A. Several events of great significance have occurred.
  - i. Babylon has been destroyed.
  - 2. The marriage of the Lamb has occurred.
  - 3. The battle of Armageddon has been concluded.
  - 4. The beast and false prophet have been cast alive into a lake of fire, burning with brimstone. 19:20.
- B. The next event that must occur before the Kingdom of God can appear is the binding of Satan.
  - Satan deceived the first family.
  - 2. He has kept at his task, he must be bound.
- I. THE BINDING OF SATAN. V1,2,3.
  - A. "And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand"
    - Key = Kleis Key, symbol of authority. When God gives the order an angel can do anything He commands
    - 2. pit = abussos the bottomless pit. This is not hell but a prison before hell, county jail, state pen.
    - 3. chain = alusis a bond, a chain, [a-luo; Not loose]
  - E. "And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent which is the devil, and satan, and bound him a thousand years"
    - 1. laid hold = Krateo to take into custody.
    - 2. dragon = The political side of Satan.
    - 3. serpent = Old, the subtile Satan, Garden of Eden.
    - 4. devil = a slander, a malignant liar. John 8:44-"He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth; when he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own; for he is a liar, and the father of it."
    - 5. satan = an adversary, an accuser, it denotes one who lies in wait to entrap, to oppose, to disable, to bring under condemnation or into disaster. John 3:18

- 6. bound = deo = to bind, to tie, fasten.
- C. "And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him."
  - 1. cast = ballo = to throw, to tumble.
  - 2. shut = kleio to shut, to close, shut up.
  - 3. set seal = sphragizo to seal, seal up, to make fast with a seal or signet. The same word as the sealing of the 144,000 in Rev. 7:1-4.
- D. "that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled; and after that he must be loosed a little season."
  - deceive = planao to make to wander, cause to err,
    lead astray, deceit and doctrinal error.
  - There is no such thing as a "holy war."
  - 3. This will prove false every idea of the modern sociologist and psychologist that man is evil because of his environment.
  - 4. little season = chronos time, duration, the time in which anything is done. It won't take satan long to lead astray those born of flesh in the 1000 years
- II. THE RESULTS OF SATAN'S BEING BOUND. V4,5,6.
  - A. The faithful are made judges.
    - 1. "And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them."
    - 2. Matt. 19:28, Peter "what shall we have therefore."
    - I Cor. 6:1-3, "the saints shall judge the world."
    - 4. The Parables. Matt. 25:14- Talents, "I will make thee ruler over many things."
  - B. The faithful saints reign with Christ.
    - "and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus."
    - 2. "and for the word of God."

- 3. "and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands."
- 4. "and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years." (They begin to reign.)
  - a. lived = zao to live, to breathe, to have life in all of its aspects.
  - b. reigned = basileur to be king, possess regal authority, to reign.
- C. The unsaved dead are left in the grave. v5
  - "But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection."
    - a. rest = loipos the remaining ones.
    - b. finished = teleo complete, to end.
    - c. There is a first and a second resurrection.
  - 2. Why would the lost desire the Kingdom?
- D. The holy ones are happy.
  - "Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection."
  - 2. part = meros a portion.
