    - 1. overcometh = vikao.
    - 2. Rev. 22:1-2.
- II. THE OVERCOMERS OF SMYRNA. 2:11
  - A. "He that overcometh shall not be hurt of the second death."
    - 1. Rev. 20:14.
- III. THE OVERCOMERS OF PERGAMOS. 2:17
  - A. "To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give unto him a stone, and in the stone

- A. "And he that overcometh and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of irom; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers; even as I received of my Father. And I will give him the morning star."
  - 1. Two requirements.
  - 2. Rod of iron = subject to another.
  - 3. rule = shepherd.
  - 4. morning star, star of hope.

#### V. THE OVERCOMERS IN SARDIS. 3:5

- A. "He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels."
  - 1. clothed in white raiment.
  - 2. will not blot out his name.
  - confess = To not only own, but to thank God for one's life.

# VI. THE OVERCOMERS IN PHILADELPHIA. 3:12

A. "Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out: And I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God which is New Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: and I will write upon him my new name."
